You may keep this page

- (1) Grass, leaves, brush and branches, and mixed yard waste generated from landscaping operations.
- (2) Report only that portion that is marketed.
- (3) Includes recycling of wood products (e.g., pallets, crates, barrels, wood furniture, canes, crutches, etc.). Materials must be mulched or composted ONLY. Otherwise, include in "Other (9)" category.
- (4) In order for a material to be classified as an animal protein/solid fat, the material must pass the Paint Filter Liquids Test.
- (5) Refurbished pallets ONLY. List mulched or composted pallets in "Wood Materials" – "Compost/Mulch (Other)" category.
- (6) Tires that are recycled into new products containing rubber (e.g., trashcans, storage containers, rubberized asphalt, etc.), and use of whole tires for playground and reef construction.
- (7) Retread or recapped tires.
- (8) Tires-to-cement kilns. Enter 12% of the total weight of tires used at cement kilns.
- (9) Write in the MRA recyclable material.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

REPLACE	toxic pesticides and cleaning products with less toxic or non-toxic alternatives
REDUCE	the amount of HHW used and purchased. Buy smaller quantities of HHW, to minimize exposure to the environment and people.
DISPOSE	items thru approved methods at HHW Events. The following items can be disposed of year-round in Allegany County
